WHAT CAN YOU DO? Don't use drugs.

If you do use drugs, make sure you have someone with you who can give you NALOXONE. Naloxone reverses the effects of opioids. Naloxone take home kits are free. (http://towardtheheart.com/naloxone/)

IF YOU MUST SMOKE ENSURE IT IS FREE OF FENTANYL.
